#### **European** University Institute

- The European University Institute (EUI) was <u>set up in 1972 by the six</u> <u>founding Member States of the European Communities</u> to provide advanced academic training to doctoral researchers and to promote research at the highest level
- It opened its doors to the first researchers in 1976
- Since then it has expanded to include new Members States of the enlarged <u>European Union</u> and has associate links to other countries, namely Switzerland, Norway and Turkey
- EUI carries out research in a European perspective in <u>Economics</u>, <u>Law</u>, <u>History and Civilization</u>, and the <u>Political and Social Sciences</u>
- As of 1994 it has a 5<sup>th</sup> Faculty: the <u>Robert Schuman Center for Advanced</u> <u>Studies</u>, to who the Florence School of Regulation belongs
- Each year more than 100 doctoral theses are defended at the EUI

#### **Florence School of Regulation**

The Florence School of Regulation (FSR) was created in 2004 by Prof. Jean-Michel Glachant with a focus on energy markets regulation; it has today four topical areas:



### **Transport Area of FSR**

- A group of scholars and researchers working on <u>regulatory policy in matters</u> of transport in the EU
- Concerned with regulation and regulatory policy of <u>all transport modes and</u> <u>markets</u> (including the relationships between them), along with <u>postal</u> and delivery services
- Started its work in <u>2010</u> with the <u>1<sup>st</sup> European Rail Transport Regulation</u> <u>Forum</u>, which brought together experts from the EC, regulators, industry stakeholders, and academics
- Since then: 9 Rail Forums
  - 6 <u>Air</u> Forums, plus one Executive Seminar
  - 5 <u>Urban</u> Forums
  - 1 Maritime Forum
  - 2 Postal Forums
  - 2 Intermodal Forum
  - 3 Academic <u>Conferences</u>

- <u>2<sup>nd</sup> Forum</u> (June 2011): Gate-to-gate air transport network management
- <u>3<sup>rd</sup> Forum</u> (April 2012): The Single European Sky: how to achieve its performance?
