





## Organisational security measures




# Integration of security measures





# **GSM-R** Railway Call Dial number 1600

By dialing the national number "1600" GSM-R mobile users on board, which are "registered" to a functional number (train conductors, train guard, security staff, railway police, etc.) are automatically connected to the closest railway police control room (15 on the national territory).



# **Counter Terrorism Security Training**

## **Objectives:**

- Cope with terrorism
- Detect abnormal / suspect behavior through body language analysis
- Crisis Management in the event of terrorist attacks
- Security of passengers and staff in the event of a terrorist attack







# **Anti-Aggression Training**



Focus on scenario analysis and on the critical situations where railway employees need to intervene

# The individual instruments

The team

- Develop the individual tools which may be used by the single employees for the prevention or management of possibile critical situation in order to guarantee personal and collective safety
- Understand the importance of a team as a resource for a quicker and safer action of its own mission



 Experiment critical situations by using all possibile resources for the identification of possibile «rule set» for their resolution

A FEW SIMPLE ADVICES FOR A SECUR AND UNTROUBLED JOURNEY

#### In the station

Make difficult pickpocket's life. They are not 

• Make sure your vehicle has been so many, not at all, but very quick.

- · Look after your luggage and never lose sight of it. Unattended luggage will be checked by
- · leep travel documents separated from your money inside your pockets; always keep your bags closed.
- · Entrance hall, ticket offices and self-services machine areas are the favourite places for pickpockets. Prepare money for tickets in advance avoiding to show to the people around you possession of other valuable.
- Don't accept rail tickets by unknown persons. Purchase rail tickets exclusively through the official Trenitalia channel of sales, illegal transactions can hide under different form of sales and/or sales at "interesting prices" and you could become victim of a fraud as well as accomplice in a crime.
- · Don't purchase services (taxi, hotel accommodation, sightseeing, luggage carrier) and goods (food items, articles of clothing, gift and household articles) from unlicensed persons.
- · Pay attention to your personal belongings when you get on and off the train.
- · For information, contact exclusively the

#### in parking lots

locked and don't leave any objects at sight on the compartment, luggage unattended while locking and unlocking the vehicle.

#### in subways

· Pay attention in case of overcrowding and don't stay longer than required.

#### on the train

- Don't leave valuables unattended in the train compartment, even if for a short time (mobile phone, computer, credit card, documents...)
- · If travelling overnight, keep your valuables in a place that is not easily accessible to others; in the sleeping wagon, don't forget to lock your compartment.
- · Beware of any unlicensed seller who, telling you touching stories, tries to take advantage of you for illegal purposes.
- · Keep an eye on your luggage at the arrival and departure of the train.
- · Always hold your rail tickets
- · Refuse any leaflets and tickets requiring money; don't contribute to increase the collection phenomenon.



intervention of Police Forces, if necessary,

### in the rail line

- Don't cross a railway level-crossing if the barriers are down or are being lowered · Never attempt to get on and off the train on
- the go.
- Don't lean out from the window and don't cross the railway lines.

#### A FEW OF THE MOST COMMON TRICKS USED TO TRY TO STEAL FROM YOU

- BUMP INTO THE VICTIM
- USE A SHEET OF CARDBOARD, NEWSPAPER OR A COAT TO COVER HAND MOVEMENT DURING THE PICKPOCKETING
- · CAUSE A CROWD WHEN GETTING ON AND OFF THE TRAINS
- · DIRTY THE VICTIM ON PURPOSE AND THEN OFFER HELP.
- ASK FOR INFORMATION TO DISTRACT THE VICTIM WHILE AN ACCOMPLICE TAKES ADVANTAGE OF
- · TELL YOU TOUCHING STORIES TO THEN ASK FOR MONEY

## Be aware! make a difference



Presta attenzione nei dassici luoghi di "lavoro" dei borseggiatori (atrii, biglietterie, aree Self Service, piattaforme di arrivo/partenza treni). Preferiscono i luoghi affollati.

Be aware of typical pickpocket "working" environments (halls and lobbies, ticket offices, Self Service areas, train arrival/departure platforms). They often prefer crowded conditions.



Attenzione mentre stai operando presso le Self Service. Prepara prima il denaro che può servirti per l'acquisto, lontano da occhi indiscreti.

Be aware of your surroundings while using the Self Service ticket machines. Prepare your purchase money beforehand, away from prying eyes.



Fai attenzione alle richieste di denaro da parte di estranei, potrebbero distrarti per consentire al complice di sottrarti il bagaglio.

Be careful of requests for money from strangers. This could be a distraction tactic to allow an accomplice to steal luggage.



Tieni sempre d'occhio il tuo bagaglio. Always keep a watchful eye on

your luggage.



Presta attenzione agli oggetti di valore anche se li conservi all'interno della giacca appesa al tuo fianco.

Pay very close attention to your valuables, even when kept inside a jacket pocket hanging at your side.



Non lasciare nulla di valore sul tavolino mentre posizioni il bagaglio sulla cappelliera. Do not leave any valuable items unattended on the table while stowing your luggage.



Anche a bordo treno, tieni d'occhio il tuo bagaglio soprattutto durante le fermate. Even on board the train, continue to keep an eye on your luggage, especially during stops.



«No ticket? No partib» Viaggiare con il biglietto è un obbligo. Acquisti il biglietto per viaggiare e non perché qualcuno potrebbe procedere ad un controllo.

"No ticket? No departure!" It is mandatory to travel with a valid ticket. Purchase a ticket to honour your travels – not simply because of patential controls.



Non acquistare servizi da persone prive di regolare licenza. Non affidare il bagaglio ad altri.

Do not acquire services from individuals not in possession of a valid license. Never entrust your lugaage to strangers.



Non acquistare generi alimentari da venditori abusivi, potrebbe essere a rischio la tua salute.

Do not purchase food items from illegal vendors. Such items may pose health hazards.
