- _ Stimulate collaboration – start small?

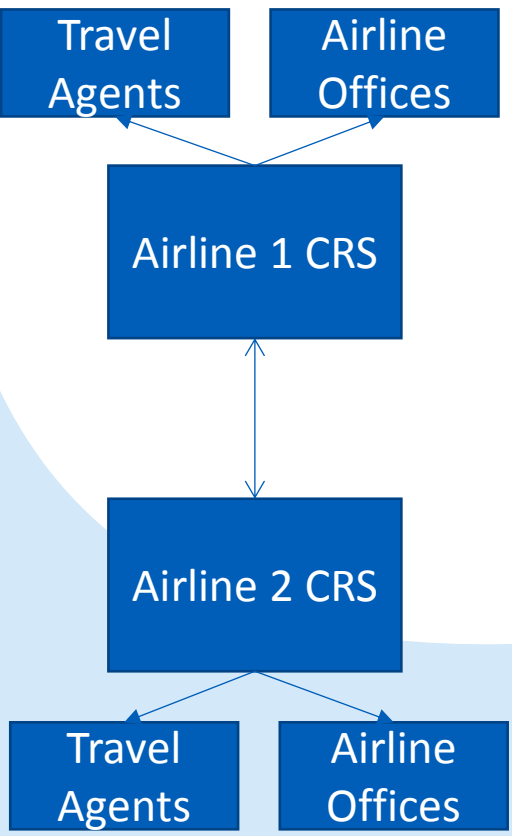

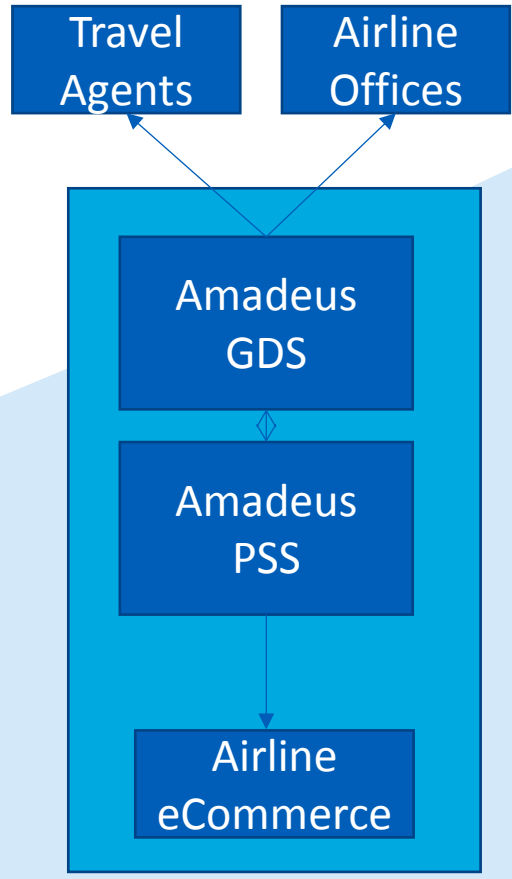
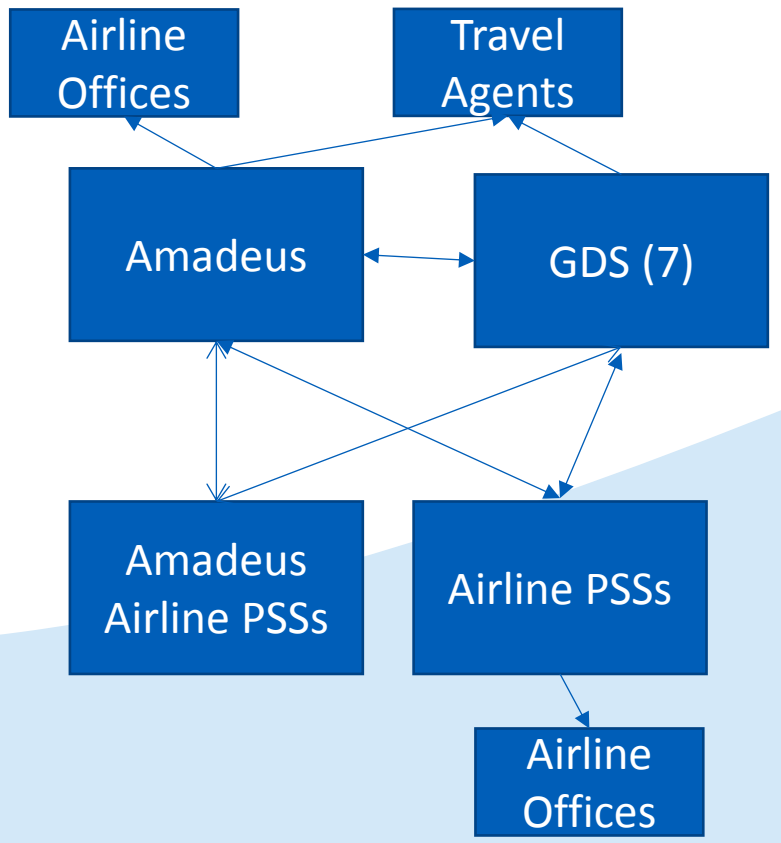
