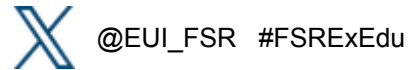

Introduction

Building on our flagship 'Specialised Training on the Regulation of Gas Markets', this new course is taking place online this year and with a renewed programme, which considers the recent developments impacting gas markets in Europe and worldwide.
