The meeting is held twice a year and provides inspiration and precious input for the focus of the FSR research along the whole year.</p> <p>The Policy Advisory Council includes representatives of all Star and Major Donors and renowned academics. Representatives from the European Commission, the Agency for the Cooperation of Energy Regulators (ACER) and National Regulatory Authorities (NRAs) are also invited to attend.</p> | <p>In the Advisory Council new initiatives and research topics are proposed and debated among all the Star and Major Donors, the FSR Director and its team. This meeting provides an interactive opportunity to learn and discuss the latest novelties and strategies of the FSR.</p> |
