


## **Specialised Training on the Regulation of Gas Markets**

## Introduction

Building on our flagship 'Specialised Training on the Regulation of Gas Markets', this new course is taking place online this year and with a renewed programme, which considers the recent developments impacting gas markets in Europe and worldwide. Understanding gas market dynamics has never been more important than today.

The course starts with a three-week preparatory block to provide participants with the core knowledge and instruments needed to approach the study of gas markets, regulation, and policy.
