- Emissions under airports' control: ~2% vs. global aviation emissions
- Airports = face of aviation on the ground
 - → Representative of the whole industry for the public
- Airports = critical interface between different stakeholders
 - → Opportunity to drive airport-wide & sector-wide climate action
- Airports = increasingly important enabler for new aircraft technologies (electrification, hydrogen, etc.)

- Flexible & progressive structure

































- Absolute long-term emissions reduction targets, aligned with Paris Agreement (IPCC scenarios), with possible inclusion of Scope 3 emissions
