Policy Advisory Council

The Policy Advisory Council discusses the most topical regulatory and policy issues and debates the relevance of the latest FSR research findings. The meeting is held twice a year and provides inspiration and precious input for the focus of the FSR research along the whole year.

The Policy Advisory Council includes representatives of all Star and Major Donors and renowned academics. Representatives from the European Commission, the Agency for the Cooperation of Energy Regulators (ACER) and National Regulatory Authorities (NRAs) may be also invited to attend.

Dedicated Internal Workshops

As an additional benefit, Star Donors have the opportunity to ask the FSR to organise, every year, an internal Workshop for their management and/or staff (or other invitees) on their premises (online while the COVID-19 restrictions are in place). Here the FSR senior faculty is available to discuss relevant topics at the Donor's request.
