Two exploitation webinars were held at the end of the project.

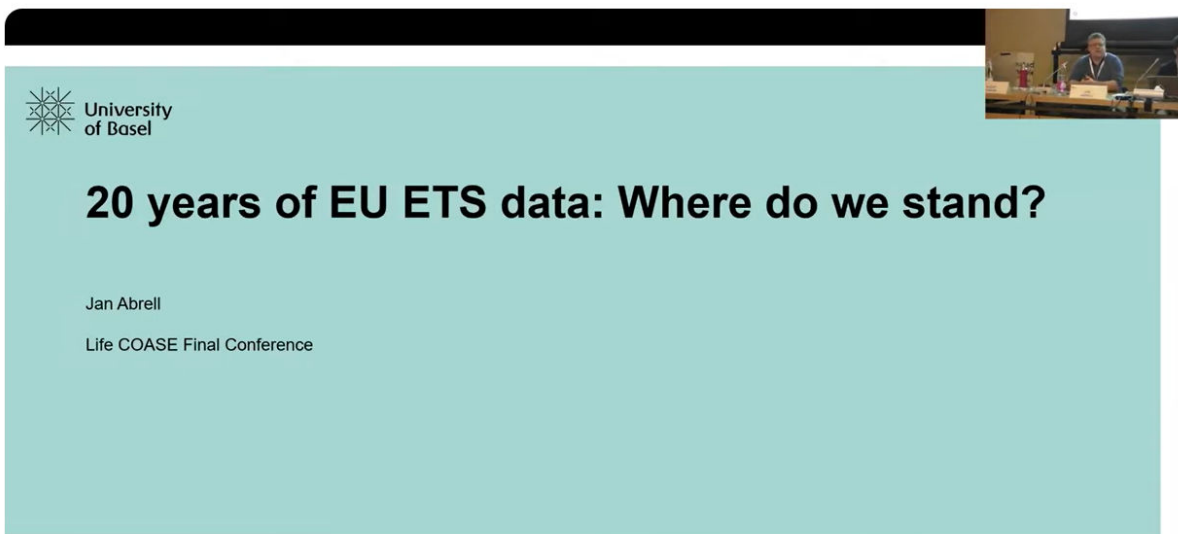
The first webinar, entitled "20 Years of EU ETS Data – Insights from the Life Coase Project," was organised in the context of the Conference on Evidence-Based Climate Policies, which took place at the EUI and online on December 1, 2025. In this webinar, Jan Abrell (University of Basel) and Marie Raude (European University Institute) introduced participants and viewers to the data that underpins the analysis and evaluation of the EU ETS. They highlighted the limitations of the available data as well as the efforts made to enhance its usability. These efforts have been an integral part of the Life Coase project and aim to pave the way for a greater quantity and higher quality of empirical studies assessing the EU ETS.
