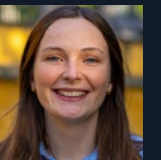

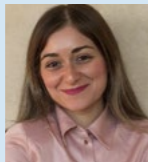

With its serene courtyard and curated art collection, Brac is perfect for a relaxed lunch or dinner with a cultural twist.

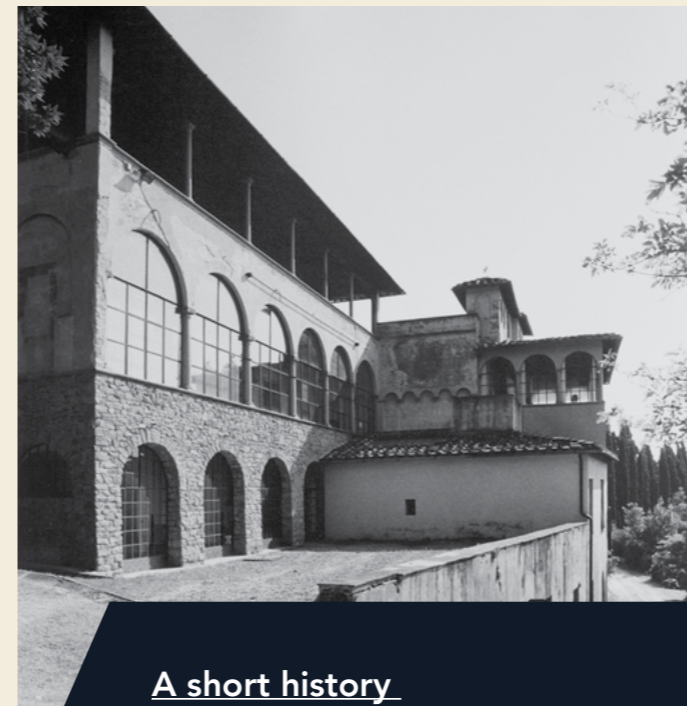
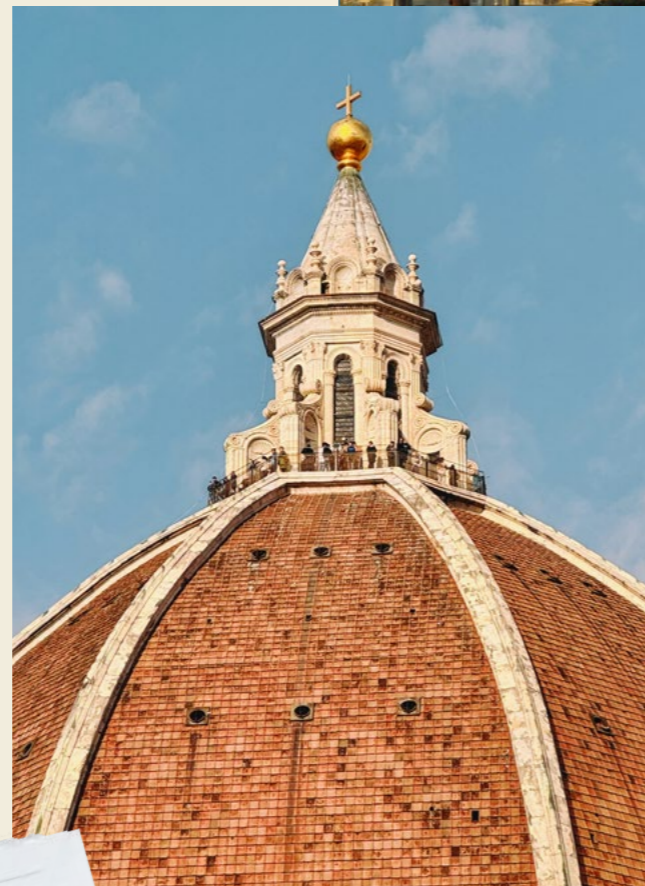
